Our 12-Week Dental Assisting Training Program will provide dental assisting training to students as a pathway to enter the dental profession as an entry-level dental assistant.

Before a dental assistant can be qualified to work with a dentist, it is important to provide basic dental knowledge to the future dental assistant. This 12 week dental assistant training program teaches students the knowledge and professionalism that it takes to be a part of the dental workforce in this exciting healthcare field. This accelerated course allows an interested student to acquire the basic entry-level dental assisting knowledge to begin their new career in as little as 12 weeks.

We realize that some people learn better from a hands-on training approach rather than a lecture approach to education, therefore the Academy for Dental Assistants has developed a curriculum for dental assistant training for this type of learner. The course is delivered in a hybrid format allowing students to attend class 1 day per week to be taught dental assisting skills while completing the book work, homework and quizzes online at home on your time. The course is divided into 4 sections, each section will have a Clinical Test from the procedures you learn in class and a Written Test that will come directly from the textbook on the chapters assigned to that section. Hands on tests are done in class; the written tests are done online. This course does require the student to spend 6-8 hours per week outside of class time to complete workbook and textbook assignments.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this program is to provide students the opportunity for a career in the dental field where they can work alongside a dentist and be able to perform a wide variety of dental assisting duties. This program will prepare students for an entry-level position in the dental field. The materials presented in this program are delivered in a hands-on approach in an actual dental office not a traditional classroom setting. The students will be evaluated on their ability to perform the necessary clinical procedures delegated to a dental assistant in the dental office.

Skills learned in this program will be reinforced through a 200-hour internship (within a minimum of 3 months maximum of 12 months) in a dental office of your choice once the 12 weeks of instruction have been completed. Students are trained in the areas of dental terminology, patient care, and chair side dental assisting.

This 6-week course is designed so that, on completion, the participant has practical experience necessary to become an Orthodontic Dental Assistant. The Course will be 4 hours 1 day per week for 6 weeks for all hands-on training. Upon completion of the course the dental assistant will be trained to:

OBJECTIVES:

Taking preliminary and post treatment photographs

Selecting and pre-sizing orthodontic bands

Selecting and pre-sizing archwires prescribed by dentist

Selecting extra-oral appliances by pre-selection or pre-measurement

Preparing a tooth surface with conditioning agents for orthodontic appliances

Removing and recementing properly contoured and fitting loose bands that are not permanently attached to any appliance

Making impressions for study models which are made for the purpose of fabricating orthodontic retainers

Placing or removing prescribed pre-treatment separators

Securing or unsecuring an archwire by attaching or removing the fastening device Removing excess cement from orthodontic appliances with non-mechanical hand instruments only
